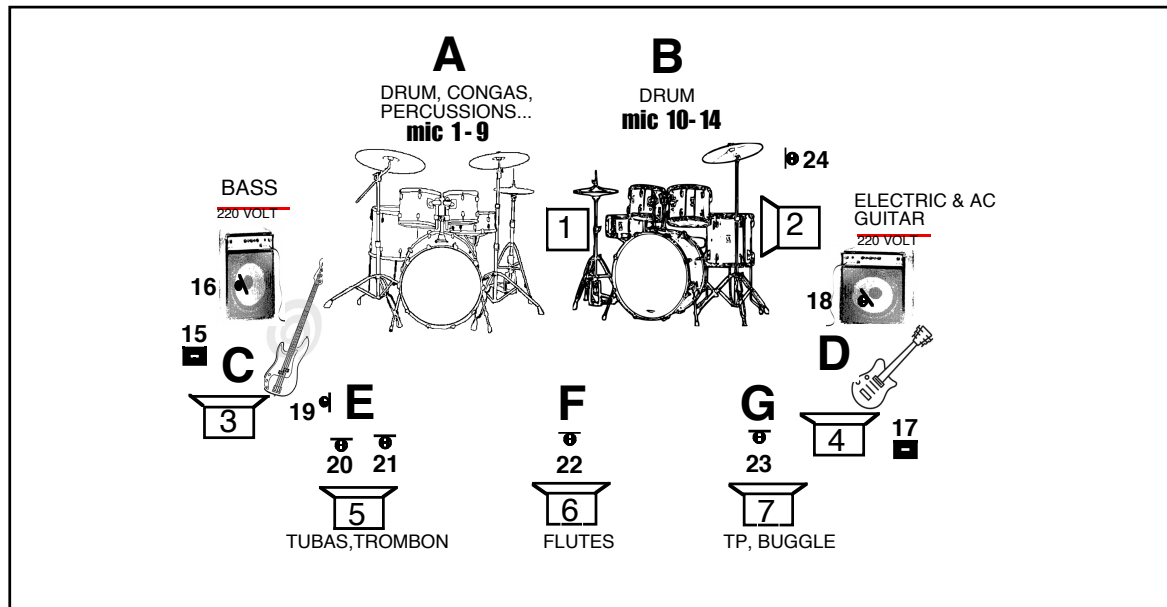

# STAGE PLAN : REO 2024



## FOH

The mixing desk should be placed in the center between the left and right PA stacks at 2/3 of the length of the venue, NEVER under balconies and always on the same level as the audience.

## DRIVE RACK :

A good stereo EQ 1/3 Oct 31 bands for the front Mix output

## PROCESSING RACK :

3 FX minimum, type M 2000, PCM 70/80, SPX 1000, SPX 900, M 5000, .....

2 reverb + 1 delays ( 1 Tap Delay )

We will use also 3 aux send for additional fx pedals we will bring

For these fx, we will need 3 aux send and 5 regular tracks on the mixing desk for their return.

All the fx send used for the processing rack & from the additional Fx pedals need to be pre send on all the tracks (mic & fx returns )

For the work in progress, It would be nice to record the concert.

## MONITORS

The monitors need to be the same type : L-Acoustics MTD 115, Nexo PS15, DNB ,...

+ EQ graphic 1/3 octave on each mix send .

The band need 7 Monitors with 7 different separate mixes .

Possible to work with 7 monitors & 5 separate mixes
